Guest Speaker:

Mr. Kirkland is our special guest to speak about the Legislative Platform for our district. Director for the District. It is a unique role. He showed us the Board Legislative Platform. It is divided into 3 sections: State Funding, State Policy and Federal (sheet distributed) #1. Teachers' salaries- continue to work on the veteran teacher salaries.
