Call to Order:

Principal's Report:

SAC Survey: The accreditation period pushed our surveys to early on in the year, so we will not have a SAC Survey at this point.

Media Guidelines- The media specialist is going through all of our books at PIA. We are currently working through the guidelines diligently and it will take some time. Mrs. Meyers will work over the summer to pull every book over the summer to make sure it meets the guidelines. Mrs. Meyers has started pulling the books already. Several books at the Scholastic Fair were pulled due to not meeting the guidelines. The teachers are following the guidelines in the classroom libraries and Mrs. Riedl trusts them. Mrs. Riedl does not want to raise a panic and we will wait on the classroom libraries until further notice. All literature circles and instruction in the middle school are following the guidelines. We do have a tight process in place with any new books coming in. There is a team that goes through the review process. Mrs. Meyers explained that even if you are buying a second title for the library it will go through the process.

Additional Agenda Topics:

Grants Available to the School for Different Expenses?- asked by Mr. Felix Navarro to Mrs. Rudin Mrs. Rudin explained that ESSR funds have been in place. ESSR 2 is until June 30th, different grants include Covid positive sick leave, hot spots, and tutors. ESSR 3 - grants for outside of the school day, learning loss, - we have to have a plan for the grant from what the schools express needs. We are exhausting our allocation funds. The school requests the funds, Mrs. Rudin explains where the funds can be pulled from. The process is the principal expresses the need and some are STEM, MATH and additional instruction after school (not tutoring). We received 4 million dollars in allocation in October, not approved until January and we have until September to use the funds. We do not expect to receive new funds. Our last lump sum is September 2024. There are funds for staff and professional development. Mrs. Kovacs asked how we should use it at PIA. Supplemental funding like after school STEM club, ART, Fundations (phonics materials), salary for outside the school day, summer work (media specialist) and paraprofessionals. There are a lot of opportunities, but Mrs. Riedl stated that she does want teachers to want to do it. Many teachers participate in Speech and Debate, Girls on the Run, and Odyssey of the Mind. If there is a need, Mrs. Riedl will complete the form for the grant. What is the status of the school loading? Growth - last year we grew a lot, this year approx. 180. 149 will go to 9th. 49 new kindergarteners have registered already. Our 1st and 5th are very large grades. Hiring MS teachers and maybe one per grade in elementary.

Any update on the salary increases for experienced teachers from the Tallahassee legislature review? Mrs. Berrera stated there is a lot of support. She doesn't expect to know a final amount until the budgets are approved – after session. The universal school voucher did pass.
