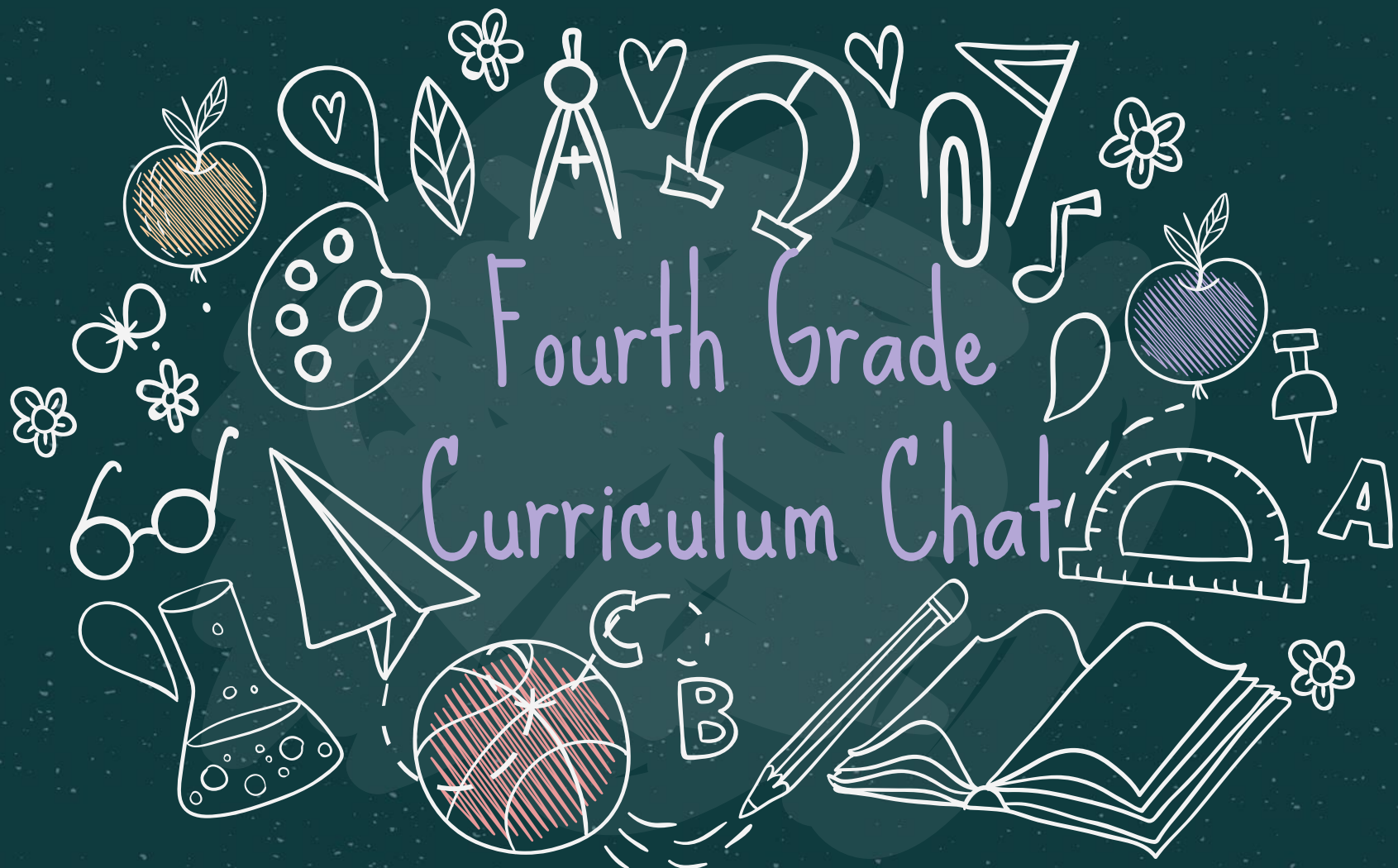

VARIOUS PROCEDURES

Attendance: It is important that your child be in class every day that is possible. School begins at 8:00 AM and dismisses at 2:20 PM.

Tardiness: A child is considered tardy after 8:00 a.m. If for some reason you are detained, please escort your child into the office to obtain a tardy slip.

Absence: Please send in a note with your child when returning to school following an illness. The office needs the excuse in writing for their records. Make up work will be given upon return.

Recess: Wear proper shoes each day and bring a water bottle.

W.I.N

"Whatever I Need"

- What is WIN?

Win is a school wide enrichment and intervention block to provide each student with what they need. Students shift to different classrooms to receive the support they need on current skills being taught.

- How are WIN groups created?

Teachers sit weekly and review data from formatives, summatives, and classroom observations to determine what each student needs weekly.

-Reteach and retest policy:

- Students who score below a 75% on a summative assessment, will be retaught and retested on the skill. Students can retest and score up to an 85%.
