I. REGISTRATION (going on NOW):

Please make sure you are encouraging those around you to complete registration ASAP. We know students are more successful when they are ready to start school the first day. To serve our families at the highest levels, making sure we are staffed is a priority and completing the registration is the only way to ensure we are fully staffed.

II. NEW FAMILY ORIENTATIONS - Presented by your Admin Team

We have prepared three(3) orientation opportunities for our new families at PIA this year.

I want to give our new families an opportunity where we share important information about Pine Island.

All orientations will be virtual for easy access to all families. <u>A TEAMS(a different link will be sent for each</u> <u>orientation) link will be sent to all families registered at Pine Island closer to the date of each</u> <u>orientation.</u> Orientations dates and times are listed below:

III. KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION -

- a. <u>Kindergarten Placement ALL</u> Kindergarten students will receive an email **from their teacher** by **Friday, August 2**.
 - i. <u>Staggered Start –</u> Teachers will include a sign-up for parents to use to choose their preferred staggered start day in their placement email. Please plan ahead!
 - ii. Staggered start dates will be August 12, 13, & 14.
 - iii. <u>ALL KINDERGARTEN</u> Students will start their first full day together on Thursday, August 15.
- **b.** <u>Pictures:</u> Pictures will be taken during <u>Meet and Greet</u> of our Kinder friends to upload into our system to ensure the safety of all students.
 - i. We will replace these pictures once we take fall pictures in September!
- c. <u>Transportation</u> During <u>Meet and Greet</u> our bus drivers will be available to answer questions and meet our newest Dolphins.



IV. <u>K – 8 MEET and GREET</u>

Students and families are invited to visit their student's classroom, meet the teacher, and drop off school supplies. **This time will not be dedicated to discovering classroom expectations**, but simply becoming acquainted with the classroom and meeting the teacher. Learning routines and schedules will be discussed during Curriculum Chat Night in September(please see PTO calendar).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION for K - 5 MEET AND GREET:

- Teachers will send placement emails to families on Tuesday, August 6 at 3:00PM, <u>except</u> <u>kindergarten – please see above for placement details.</u>
- Meet and Greet times have been scheduled alphabetically by last name to ensure families have parking available.
- Kindergarten students ONLY are invited to come 30 minutes early to avoid the large crowds during their scheduled time. This is optional!

Please join us to walk your schedule, receive locker information, & drop off your school supplies if you choose. I have found that this gives our students a way to move around the campus without pressure and even visit with friends while walking their schedules.

Middle school teachers **WILL NOT** be available on this day. This day is solely to give our students an "additional" opportunity to spend time walking their schedules and becoming acquainted with their locker.

- <u>LOCKER UPDATES Academic lockers</u> will be <u>OPTIONAL</u> again this year at PIA. We understand not all students want to use a locker. For this reason,
 - The deadline to request an academic locker to be issued on Schedule-Walk Day is Friday, August 2.
 - For students that **do not request prior to August 2**, they will have an opportunity to request an academic locker beginning August 9.
 - These lockers will be issued at the start of school.
