
## COMMUNICATION

# Fintastic BEGAVIOR Capturing Kids Hearts






•Students are greeted at the doorway each morning with a smile, asked how they are, and then encouraged to greet others. We start each day by sharing good news.


•Our classes have each developed a social contract together, which identifies our core values, builds respect, and promotes positive interactions and encouragement for one another.



Classroom Assessments = tasks, quick checks, unit tests

Report cards and assessed work will be given the letters of M, P, or I.

M - Meeting the standard (85-100%)

P - Progressing towards the standard (70-84%)

I - Needs Improvement (Below 69%) Each quarter has various standards that are taught or become more complex as the year progresses. A student could receive a M in one quarter, but a P or I in a different quarter due to increasing complexity of the standard.

Only P or I will appear on interims due to the entire standard not having been taught yet.


### STAR ASSESSMENTS

The STAR Assessments are online assessments that help aid your child's teacher in determining your student's needs, personalizing their learning, and monitoring their progress throughout the school year.

The STAR test is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit your child's needs. Each item a student sees is individualized based on their answer to the previous question.

It is administered 3 times a year (August, December & May)

Parents can help their child by encouraging them to take their time and do their best. Remind them not to be discouraged if the questions seem difficult because they want to see how much your brain can stretch and grow!

#### **PHONICS**

We will be using the **FUNdations curriculum in** order to teach phonics in class. Fundations is a systematic and explicit phonics instructional program. This program is aimed to teach foundational basics for reading and spelling.



#### READING

SAVVAS MyView Literacy is an all encompassing reading and writing curriculum. Students will be exposed to various texts and strategies to develop strong reading and writing skills.

Supplemental resources will be used throughout the school year that support our state standards.

#### **ENVISION MATH**

EnVision Math is a hands on math curriculum that focuses on exploring concepts through the eyes of the student. It includes engaging lessons with online resources for the twenty first century of learning.

#### **CENTERS**

Students will engage in math centers that will practice and target specific math skills and standards. Math centers can be differentiated based on the mastery of skill.



### "WHATINEED"

Throughout the year, first grade teachers will be using flexible switch groups across our team of teachers. Teachers will be meeting weekly to discuss grade level data and choose lessons that meet the needs of each student.

Within small groups, students will be participating in activities and lessons targeting specific skills which match their individual needs and levels.
