STAR Testing

- The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring tool that will be administered three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year.
- FAST assessments are computer-adaptive tests taken on a computer or tablet. The questions get easier or more difficult depending on how the student responds, and each student will see different questions.
- The Star Reading assessment is usually completed in less than 20 minutes, and the Star Math assessment typically takes less than 30 minutes to complete.

Second Grade Assessments



- Fountas and Pinnell (F & P) Benchmark Assessment System (BAS)
 - This is an assessment of your child's current reading level. This is a complete reading assessment that is given individually to each student using a series of texts to identify a student's reading level and covers fluency, comprehension and accuracy.
 - Students are assessed each quarter of the school year.
 - Second Grade Expectations are:

• 1st Quarter: Level J

2nd Quarter: Level K

• 3rd Quarter: Level L

4th Quarter: Level M

Second Grade Assessments



•Pine Island Academy Assessments:

- Post Tests, Quick Checks, and Monitoring in the Classroom
 - Students are always being assessed informally throughout the learning process (observations, conferring, anecdotal notes, etc.)
 - Students will be assessed during learning Quick Check (Quiz).
 - Students will be assessed after learning Post Test (Summative Test).
 - Formatives (quizzes) are 30% of their grade
 - Summatives (tests) are 70% of their grade
- How your child will be assessed throughout 2nd grade. This grading scale is used on summative assessments.

Report Cards:

- Second Grade uses a standards-based report card.
- Report cards will be available on the Home Access Center (HAC) at the end of each quarter. A
 paper copy will not be sent home.

The second grade standards are taught in "parts" throughout the year. Students will only be assessed on the parts of the standards taught in the current grading period. The standards will become more complex as we cover more of the standard so, they could earn a "M" Meeting Standards one quarter but earn a "P" progressing toward the standard during the next quarter.

Interim Grades:

- Will be sent home in the middle of each quarter in your child's daily folder.
- Please note that Interim Grades will be marked as "P's" for progressing and "I's" for Needs Improvement.







Resource and WATT

Classroom Reminders:
