# ***Standards, Scales, and End of Course Exam***

All information taught in class is based on state standards.

Standards are posted on scales and students keep a copy of the scales and refer to it daily to ensure they are clear on the learning objectives for the class every day.

**The class standards will be tested at the end of the school year on an End of Course state exam.**



## ***End of Course Exam***

Civics is a required course for every middle schooler in the state of Florida

The end of course exam is a state test that all people who take middle school Civics.

The goal is for every student to achieve a level 3 or above (on a 5 point scale)



# County Grading Policy

70% of student's grade will come from Summative grades

30% of student's grade will come from Formative grades

Summatives can be remediated and retaken. Standards on the formatives will be reassessed on the Summative and the grade can be changed if the student scores better on those standards. Essentially the summative is the formative's retake.
