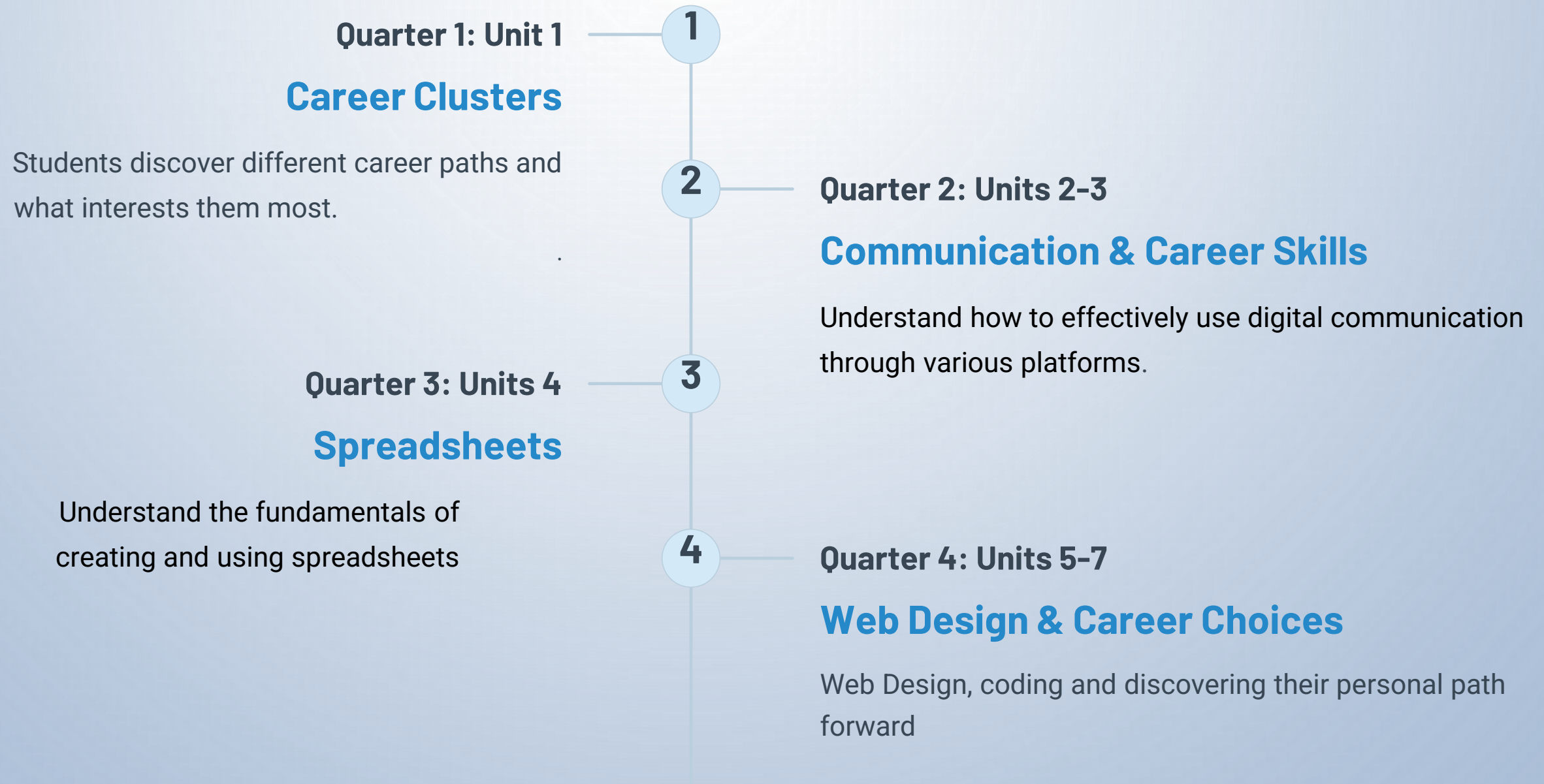

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Quarter 1: Unit 1

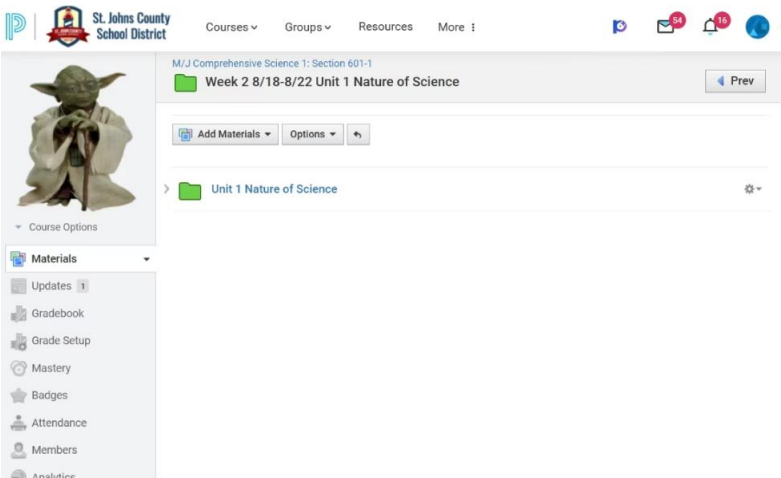
Navigating Your Student's Digital Classroom

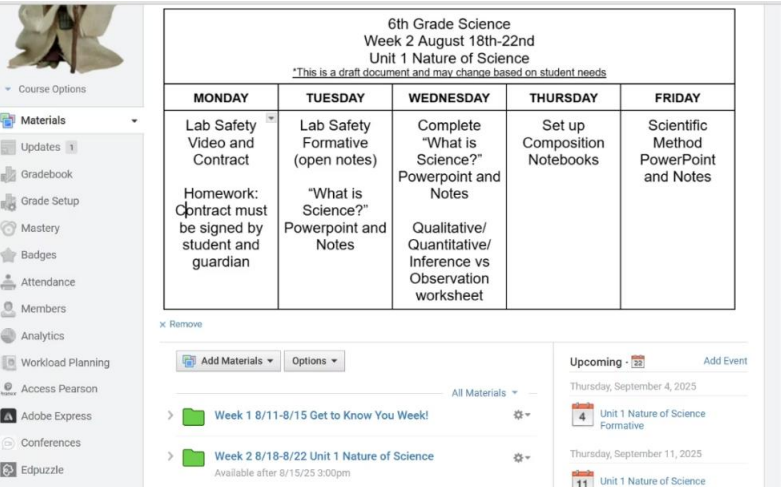
See this week's plan and which unit we're exploring. Schedules may adjust based on student needs!

Weekly Unit Breakdown

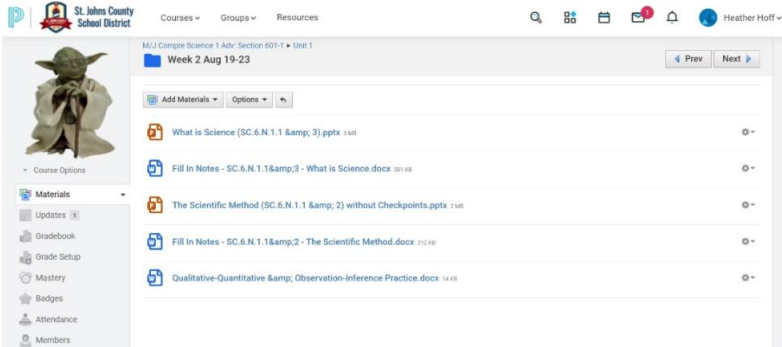
Each unit is organized by week so you can follow along with our progress.

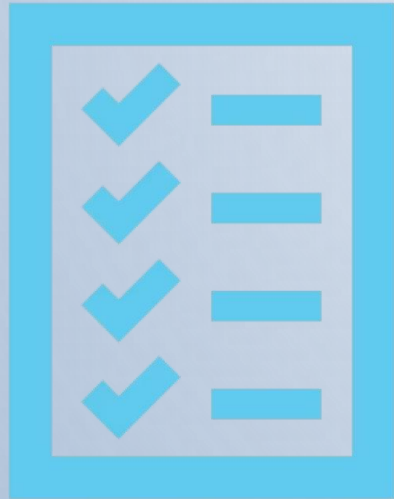

Understanding Your Student's Grades

HAC - Home Access Center



This is where all graded assignments appear and where you can monitor your child's progress throughout the year.

You might see these codes in HAC:

INC = Incomplete

Assignment not finished or turned in. Could be due to absence or forgetting to submit.

EXT = Excused

Class activity done while absent that's hard to make up (like labs). Won't affect their grade.

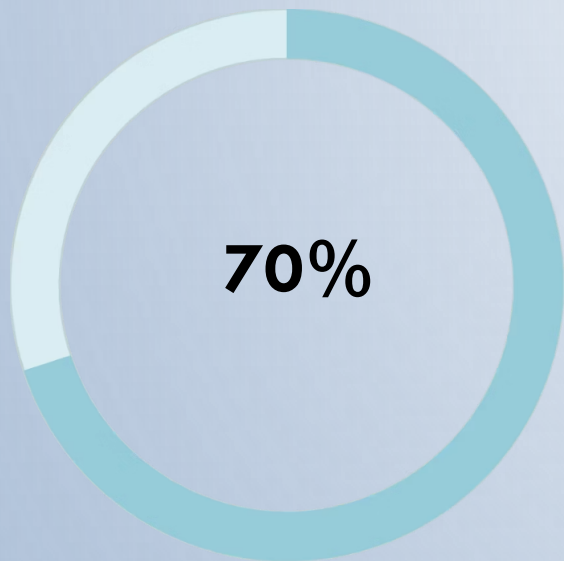
INO = Zero

Student chose not to attempt work despite support offered.

How We Calculate Grades

Your student's grade comes from two main categories that reflect different types of learning:

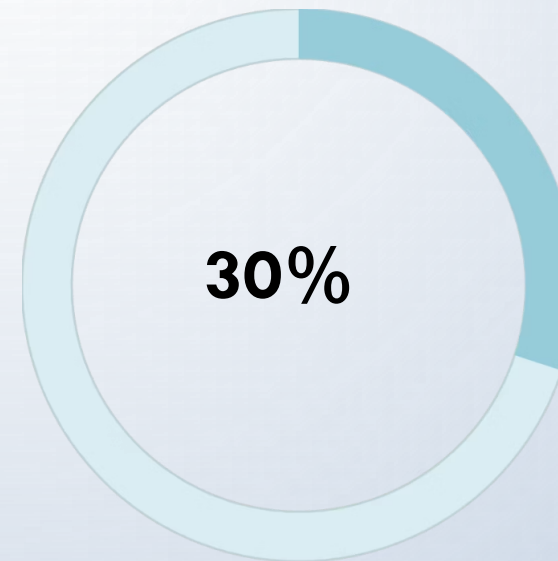
Summative (CSA)



Major unit tests that show mastery of big concepts

- End-of-unit projects
- Major assessments
- Comprehensive assignments

Formative (CFA)



Quizzes and classwork that help us practice and learn

- Daily assignments
- Practice activities
- Participation work

✅ **Good News!** Students can retake unit summatives if they score below 75%. We believe in growth and second chances!



Supporting Your Student's Success

Establish a Consistent Homework Routine

Create a dedicated time and quiet space for your student to complete assignments. This helps build good study habits that will serve them throughout their education.

Check Schoology Weekly Together

Take 10 minutes each week to review upcoming assignments and due dates with your child. This simple habit promotes responsibility and prevents last-minute surprises.
