I. REGISTRATION (going on NOW):

Please make sure you are encouraging those around you to complete registration ASAP. We know students are more successful when they are ready to start school the first day. To serve our families at the highest levels, making sure we are staffed is a priority and completing the registration is the only way to ensure we are fully staffed.

II. BUS INFORMATION (ALL FAMILIES – NEW and RETURNING) – All hyperlinks have been provided for easy access!

ALL FAMILIES who have students that ride the bus, **MUST** log-in to the [Bus Planner website](#) to create an account if you have not done so previously!

This will be the ONLY WAY families will be able to access bus schedules when Transportation releases bus schedules the last week of July. Detailed instructions showing how to login to BusPlanner and **how to access your child's bus schedule**, are now available on the [school district website](#).

III. KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION – Presented by your Admin Team

IV. NEW FAMILY ORIENTATION – Presented by your Admin Team

We have prepared an orientation opportunity for our new families at PIA this year.

This is a way our Admin Team can share important information about Pine Island with all new families.

All orientations will be virtual for easy access to all families. **TEAMS link will be sent to all families registered at Pine Island closer to the date of each orientation.** Orientations dates and times are listed below:

- **1st – 8th grade New Family Orientation – Monday, July 27 – 6:45PM**
 - *We will give 1st – 5th grade families the opportunity to exit the orientation when we move into middle school ONLY information*

V. KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION –

- a. **Kindergarten Placement** - ALL Kindergarten students will receive an email **from their teacher** by **Friday, July 31**.
 - i. **Staggered Start** – Teachers will include a sign-up for parents to use to choose their preferred staggered start day in their placement email. Please plan ahead!
 - ii. **Staggered start dates will be August 10, 11, 12, OR 13.**
 - iii. **ALL KINDERGARTEN** Students will start their first full day together **on Friday, August 14**.
- b. **Pictures:** Pictures will be taken of our Kinder friends to upload into our system to ensure the safety of all students.
 - i. **We will replace these pictures once we take fall pictures in September!**
- c. **Transportation** - During Meet and Greet our bus drivers will be available to answer questions and meet our newest Dolphins.

VI. K – 5th grade ONLY - MEET AND GREET DATES AND TIMES –

Students and families are invited to visit their student's classroom, meet the teacher, and drop off school supplies. **This time will not be dedicated to discovering classroom expectations** but simply becoming acquainted with the classroom and meeting the teacher. Learning routines and schedules will be discussed during Curriculum Chat Night the last week of August.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION for Meet and Greet

- Teachers will send placement emails to families on **August 4 at 3:00PM, except kindergarten – please see above for placement details.**
- Meet and Greet times have been scheduled alphabetically **by last name** to ensure families have parking available.
- **Kindergarten students ONLY are invited to come 30 minutes early** to avoid the large crowds during their scheduled time. **This is optional**

 - M – Z (Last Name) – 10:30AM – 11:30AM

VIII. MIDDLE SCHOOL SCHEDULE WALKT – August 6 – 8:30AM – 11:00AM

- a. 6th, 7th, & 8th grade
- b. Please use the sign-up genius below to schedule a time to pick up and walk schedule.
 - a. **Middle School Schedule-Walk Sign Up**

- Please join us to walk your schedule, receive locker information, & drop off your school supplies if you choose. I have found that this gives our students a way to move around the campus without pressure and even visit with friends while walking their schedules.
- Middle school teachers **WILL NOT** be available on this day. This day is solely to give our students an “additional” opportunity to spend time walking their schedules and becoming acquainted with their locker.

IX. ACADEMIC LOCKER UPDATES – Academic lockers will be **OPTIONAL** again this year at PIA. We understand not all students want to use a locker. For this reason,

- a. The **deadline to request an academic locker** to be issued on **Schedule-Walk Day** is **5 PM on Monday, August 3.**
- b. For students that do not request prior to 5 PM on August 3, they will have an opportunity to request an academic locker beginning **August 8 during Meet & Greet with Dean Lawhorn.**
- c. These lockers will be issued at the start of school.
